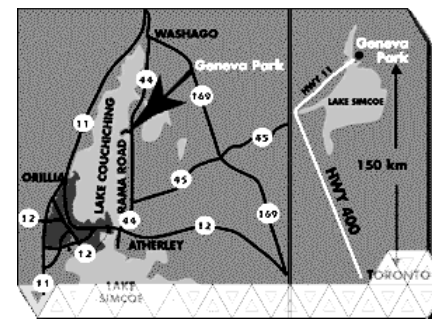

From the North –  
From Hwy 11 south, exit at Hwy 69 south (to Whitby) proceed 1 Km through Washago and turn right at the road to Longford Mills (county Road 21) proceed south 8.5 KM. Turn right at Geneva Park entrance.

From the South -  
From Hwy 11 north, exit at Hwy 12 south (at Orillia) and follow 12 south until you are over the bridge at the narrows to Rama Rd, turn left and proceed past Casino Rama (don't stop!) through Longford Mills and turn left into entrance of Geneva Park.

**KIRSTIN BOJANOWSKI- OPEN MEDIA \$375.00**

Kirstin Bojanowski's weekend workshop with acrylic and mixed media is a fearless dive into abstract painting. Expect to be open and playful with colour, texture and movement. Over the course of two days, we will paint one to two canvases from start to finish and engage principles of balance through building layers. Layering techniques include using plasters, tissue and rice papers, sand and other materials to create texture on the canvas as a foundation before we start painting. Discussion and inspirational guidance of colour will be provided through a series of demonstrations and paint-alongs through out the day. In this course you will learn many helpful insights to get you started with abstract painting, but remember, a wonderful characteristic about this genre is that there are always exceptions to the rules and experimentation is key!
